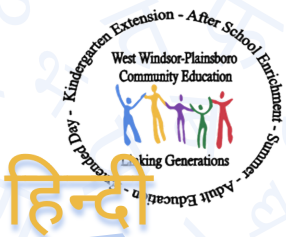

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Registration Information

Online registration is available at www.ww-p.org, under Departments, click Community Education. Or, click [HERE](#) for the Community Pass Registration link. Once in Community Pass, click on 2022 Summer Hindi. Registration closes at NOON, one week before the class is to begin.

If you have an existing balance on your Community Pass account, you will be unable to register for future programs.

Payment Policy

Payment for each program is due at the time of registration and can be made online using a credit card or e-check. There is a 2.8% service charge for all credit card transactions. There is a \$10 non-refundable registration fee for all Community Education sponsored programs.

Pre-Class Evaluation

Students will be required to complete a level evaluation prior to the start of the program. Should you not fit the ability level to which your child is registered, Community Education will be contacted by the instructor and your Community Pass account will be refunded.

Community Education must confirm any level or class changes with the instructor prior to making changes to your account.

Withdrawal & Refund Policy

Program withdrawals for a refund will be accepted by NOON, up to ONE WEEK before the start of a new class.
